Our School

St Teresa's is a Roman Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School providing education for approximately 350 children, including Pre-school aged children. The school buildings and grounds are owned by the Diocese of Portsmouth and has close links with Corpus Christi Church which is on the same site.

Our school is a one and a half form entry. We have two Foundation II classes, three Key Stage 1 classes (one Year 1, one Year 2 and 1 mixed), three Lower Junior classes (one Year 3, one Year 4 and 1 mixed), and four Upper Junior classes (two Year 5 and two Year 6).

In Summer 2010 St Teresa's was inspected by OFSTED and assessed to be an outstanding school. A copy of the report is available at www.ofsted.gov.uk (Unique Reference Number 110032).

Primary School Admissions 2021/22

If your child is born on or between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017, he/she will be due to start full time education at primary school in September 2021.

- All applications for schools should be made through the School Admissions Team at the Wokingham Borough Council; applications cannot be made directly to the school.
- Parents should register their interest in applying for a school place. This can be by phone (0118) 974 6000 or online at www.wokingham.gov.uk/admissions
- Following this registration, an application pack will be sent to your home address from mid November. If you have not received a pack by December, you must contact the School Admissions Team.
- Applications can be submitted by post or online from 13 November 2020.
- If you are applying to St Teresa's on denominational grounds please complete a Supplementary Information form. This can be found on the school website under Admissions.
- This form needs to be submitted to the school office with the original of your child's baptismal certificate (please contact your parish office if you do not have a copy) and a proof of address (eg. Utility bill).

- The deadline for all applications is 15 January 2021. Applications received after this date will be treated as late and will be processed after the main allocation.
- Parents will be notified of their child's allocated school place on 16 April 2021 by e-mail (if submitted online) and also by post.
- Parents must accept their places by the deadline given with their offers.
- The number of children to be admitted in 2021/2022 is intended to be 45. The admission number is compatible with the duty to comply with Infant class size legislation. The teaching group size at Key Stage 1 will not exceed 30.
- There will be one point of entry at September 2021.
